

An Bill To Impede Air Pollution

1 BE IT ENACTED BY THE STUDENT CONGRESS HERE ASSEMBLED THAT

2 Section 1. There will be a 60 percent cut in sulfur and nitrogen emissions from 3 1997 levels
by 2025.

4 Section 2. All funding will be overseen by the EPA

5 A. The EPA will provide \$15 million a year through fiscal year 2025 to

6 implement the requirements of legislation

7 Section 3. There will be a required use of low-sulfur coal in coal burning power 8 plants.

9 A. There will be a required washing of coal prior to burning it in said coal

10 burning power plants.

11 Section 4. This bill shall go into effect 180 days after passage.

12 Section 5. All laws in conflict with this legislation are hereby declared null and 13 void.

A Bill to Establish Congressional Term Limits

1 BE IT ENACTED BY THE CONGRESS HERE ASSEMBLED THAT:

2 SECTION 1. All members of both the House and Senate shall have their

3 opportunity of re-election restricted by congressional term limits.

4 SECTION 2. All members of the House shall serve a maximum of four
terms.

5 A. These terms may be served consecutively or individually; however, the
7 maximum number of terms will be four and two for the House and
8 Senate, respectively.

9 B. Terms served in one body of Congress do not impede an individual's
10 ability to serve in another. For instance, if an individual wanted to serve
11 four terms in the House and two in the Senate, they would have the
12 ability to do

13 SECTION 3. The Federal Election Commission will oversee the
14 enforcement of this legislation.

15 SECTION 4. This bill shall be implemented by the fiscal year 2022.

16 SECTION 5. All laws in conflict with this legislation are hereby declared
null and void.

A Bill to Ban Fracking

1 BE IT ENACTED BY STUDENT CONGRESS HERE ASSEMBLED THAT

2 Section 1. This bill prohibits federal agencies from issuing permits for the

3 expansion of fracking or fracked oil and natural gas infrastructure,

4 including infrastructure intended to extract, transport, or burn natural

5 gas or oil. By 2030 all fracking permits will be revoked. By 2030 the

6 United States will be fracking free.

7 Section 2. "Hydraulic fracturing or fracking is a process to extract underground

8 resources such as oil or gas from a geologic formation by injecting

9 water, a propping agent (e.g., sand), and chemical additives into a

10 well under enough pressure to fracture the geological formation. "

11 Section 3. The Department of Energy and Environmental Protection Agency

12 shall be deemed responsible for implementing this bill

13 Section 4. Upon passage, this legislation will take effect on January 1st, 2022

14 Section 5. All laws that conflict with this will be declared null and void

1. **A BILL TO COMBAT CHINESE INFLUENCE IN THE SOUTH CHINA SEA**
2. **Section 1.** The United States will increase its funding of the countries close to
3. the South China Sea (Japan, South Korea, Philippines, Indonesia, Australia,
4. India, and Pakistan) from a total of 6 Billion dollars to 20 Billion Dollars.
5. This money will also be used to improve American Military bases in these
6. countries, increase American presence in the South China Sea, as well as to
7. help subsidize the armies of these various countries to combat China. Also as
8. part of this bill the United States will formally recognize the Republic of
9. China as an independent state. **Section 2.** “Recognize” is defined as formal
10. acknowledgment of the political existence of a government or nation.
11. **Section 3.** The State Department will be in charge of allocating the extra 14
12. billion dollars given to the US military as well as how much money will be
13. given to each country in Asia.
 - a. A. The Defense Department must use the money allocated by this bill in the South China Sea and not allocate it to other areas of concern
 - b. B. The other countries receiving aid must use all money allocated to them on improving their militaries and be subject to review by US State Department and Defense Department officials
14. **SECTION 4.** This bill will go into effect on January 1st, 2024.
15. **SECTION 5.** All laws in conflict with this legislation are hereby declared null and void

A BILL TO DECRIMINALIZE DRUGS IN THE UNITED STATES

1. **Section 1.** All drug use in the United States shall be decriminalized and the
2. funds used for jailing people with drug histories will be put towards
3. increasing funding to existing residential rehabilitation facilities for former
4. drug users **Section 2.** “Decriminalize” is defined as the removal of criminal
5. penalties; “drugs” is defined as narcotics, depressants, stimulants,
6. hallucinogens, and anabolic steroids as listed under the Controlled
7. Substances Act. **Section 3.** The Drug Enforcement Agency and The Justice
8. Department will carry out the decriminalization of penalties of drug use in
9. the United States **SECTION 4.** This bill will go into effect on January 1st,
10. 2023.
11. **SECTION 5.** All laws in conflict with this legislation are hereby declared null and void.
